

Proposition 65 Statement

Proposition 65 (Prop 65) requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. California's Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) adopted amended regulations for the provision of "clear and reasonable" warnings under Prop 65 (Title 27, CA Code of Regulations) in August 2016 with the changes effective August 30, 2018. OEHHA further amended Prop 65 effective January 1, 2025. Businesses have until January 1, 2028 to comply with the new requirements which include updating short-form warnings to incorporate the name of at least one specific chemical.

ITW Pro Brands reviewed its product lines and updated the Prop 65 warning located on affected product packaging to comply with the 2016 requirements and is currently updating affected products to comply with the new requirements by the 2028 deadline. When a Prop 65 warning is required, it is located on the smallest sellable unit (e.g. tube, marker, aerosol, etc.), thus providing a "clear and reasonable" warning to consumers.
